If your quilt is not original, credit the quilter, pattern maker, or book that inspired you. Remember, visitors will read many of these at our show. We may edit your description.

Item Priority: We ask that you **prioritize** the quilts in the order you want them in the show. For example if you're entering Quilt1, Quilt2, Jacket, and Hanging and you want the hanging in the show the most, it would have priority 1; while Quilt2 (the next one you want to see in the show), would be priority 2, and so on.
