

HERRINGBONE STITCH TUTORIAL





The Herringbone stitch is a stitch which can be used for decorative purposes or to join 2 fabrics together. This was often used when joining lace panels.

Starting with the first box on the left, bring your needle from the back of your work and up at A. Continue with the needle up and insert at B. I have put arrows to indicate the direction you should be travelling with your needle.

In the second box at the top, from B, take your needle along the back of your work and come out at C.

In the third box we travel from C and insert the needle at D in the front.

In the bottom box, we travel from D at the back of your work and come out to the front at E, travel up and insert in at F. This completes your stitch. Remember to keep your stitches even. There are several variations on this stitch which can be done with lacing, wrapping and knotting.
